Potential trade pact opens wine opportunities...

INDIAN RESCUE?

ECONOMIC relief could be around the corner for wine producers across the Adelaide Hills, with the State government exploring new trading opportunities with global partners.

Minister for Trade and

Investment, and Taylor MP, Nick Champion recently hosted India's High Commissioner to Australia, Manpreet Vohra, to discuss a trade deal between the two constituencies.

Under the trade pact, tariffs on wine with a minimum import price of

approximately \$7.25 a bottle would be cut immediately and decreased by more than 100 per cent over the period of a decade.

Kavel MP Dan Cregan welcomed the announcement of the trade pact.
